CHARITI HOME MINISTRIES RECEIVES \$10,000 2:1 CHALLENGE BROWN SISTERS FOUNDATION GRANT & A \$3,500 AMEREN GRANT TO EXPAND PROGRAMMING

Belleville, IL-Chariti Home Ministries, a 501c3, providing coaching, mentoring, workforce development, spiritual guidance and connections to community resources for teen parents in the Metro East, has been awarded a \$10,000 2:1 Challenge Grant from the Brown Sisters Foundation. This grant supports the expanded Lions of Judah program, focusing on teen dads. We believe focusing on teen fathers is critical not only to the stability of their children but also to strengthening the family unit. In addition, Chariti Home Ministries received a \$3,500 Grant from Ameren-Illinois to continue services for its Seeds of Promise and Lions of Judah Teen Parent Programs.

CHM has developed programming to include Teen Parent Education and One-On-One Mentoring for parents 13-19 years of age via our Seeds of Promise, Teen Moms and Lions of Judah, Teen Dads.

The non-profit has served over 725 single, displaced, and unhoused teen parents in its 16-year existence and looks forward to expanding CHM's positive impact on teen parents.

KONNISHA D LOCKETT CHARITI HOME EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



Konnisha is the single mother of three and a native of Alorton Illinois. Konnisha became interested in Chariti Home Ministries and participated in the Seeds of Promise program. Upon program completion and obtaining her GED, Konnisha was awarded two scholarships and entered nursing school to become a Licensed Practical Nurse, specializing in community health and education, with emphasis on obstetrics and women's health. In addition, she has certificates in Intravenous Therapy Administration, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation, with AED defibrillator, and soon to be a Graduate Registered Nurse.

Konnisha began her journey in nursing at a very early age. Having been raised in a low-income home, she was introduced to the Boys and Girls Club of Illinois where her Big Sister was a Registered Nurse, practicing at BJC Hospital. Konnisha is currently pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Nursing at the University of Missouri-St. Louis.

She has worked in the medical field for 12 years (geriatric long-term care, assisted living memory care, behavior and psychiatric skilled nursing, medical-surgical acute care hospital, community health clinical setting). Konnisha serves as a Community Health Advocate to accentuate Black public health and is the owner of Imagine U LLC, a XXX. She also volunteers for the Black Nurse Association of Greater St. Louis as the Program Committee Chair, while training as the newly appointed Executive Director of Chariti Home Ministries.

Konnisha's goal is to gain a Doctor of Nursing Science in Obstetrics and Women's Health, while continuing to serve families of color by partnering with local nonprofit community organizations that support the agenda of black family development.
